 - ❖ candidates/issues fairs
 - ❖ celebrating new neighbors & businesses
 - ❖ timely air quality & land use issues
- > facilitating regular Board and committee meetings, including Land Use & Transportation, Communication, Environmental, the Rose City Park Revitalization Project, and Events.
