



Rose City Park Neighborhood Association Community Partners Program

The Rose City Park Neighborhood Association (RCPNA) is composed of dedicated people, businesses, and organizations in Rose City Park that work together to host community meetings, provide information about local happenings, and produce neighborhood events throughout the year.

RCPNA services and events include:

- Hosting four general membership meetings, including candidate/issues fairs, celebrations of new neighbors and business, and current land use and environmental issues
- Facilitating regular RCPNA Board and committee meetings, including Land Use & Transportation, Communication, Environmental, Events and Rose City Park Playground Project
- Publishing newsletters, e-mail updates, a website, and Facebook page focused on neighborhood news
- Collaborating with the Hollywood Neighborhood Association in a Spring Clean-up Event, two Picnic in the Park Concerts and National Night Out – free for all neighbors!
- Organizing and facilitating neighborhood walking tours, supporting natural area enhancements (e.g. removal of Himalayan blackberries), and supporting Frazier Park Community Garden
- Performing “random acts of neighborliness” for neighbors needing help or assistance
