

Acceptable item categories

- furniture
- mattresses
- glass
- electronics
- rubber
- corded appliances
- computers
- carpet
- clean wood (no paint or stain on the piece)
- tires (on and off the rim)
- scrap metal
- BBQ's
- bikes, trikes, scooters, etc
- hard styrofoam and #6 plastic CAN be recycled (NO PACKAGING PEANUTS)
 - Examples of #6 plastics that CAN be recycled:
 - disposable plates and cups
 - meat trays
 - egg cartons
 - carry-out containers
 - pill bottles
 - compact disc cases

and MORE CLEAN TRASH

Items that CANNOT BE ACCEPTED

- waste and recyclables collected at curbside
- kitchen garbage
- residential yard debris and trimmings
- construction, demolition and remodeling waste
- concrete, dirt, sod, sand
- roofing
- commercial landscaping
- animal waste
- HAZARDOUS WASTE (any products that contain the words "warning", "caution", "flammable", or "poison")
 - wood with paint or stain (clean wood only)
 - asbestos containing material
 - pesticides and poisons
 - paints and stains
 - cleaners and disinfectants
 - thinners and solvents
 - sharps (medical syringes)
 - batteries
 - incandescent bulbs
 - fluorescent bulbs or tubes (including CFLs)
 - neon lights
 - aerosols
 - automotive products
 - thermometers
 - pool and spa chemicals
 - hobby chemicals
 - fire extinguishers
 - heating oil
 - pharmaceuticals
 - ink cartridges (toner, laser and ink jet cartridges for printers, copiers and fax machines)
